The Breeder Champion Rosette went to Mandy and Nigel Hill and the Dunsmore Stud for the second year running with Dunsmore Glenfiddich ("Muffin") standing overall Champion and Dunsmore the Famous Grouse taking the Performance Championship.

Overall Champion with 'Muffin' Annette Perry describes their year together.

"Muffin and I have had a very varied and enjoyable 2015.

We have galloped about madly on some pleasure and endurance rides. Our favourite was 20 miles round Grimsthorpe Castle Estate with 2 friends on their Thoroughbreds. Lots of grassy canters and an uphill gallop which involved spooking at the cameraman halfway up and shooting sideways. We have done quite a bit of showjumping up to 2ft 6", including a pairs class with my friends cob.

At Equifest in August we entered 6 classes and got placed in 5, the best result was 3rd in the Exmoor geldings where we were the highest placed veteran. Then we had a fantastic day out at the Midlands Exmoor Show where we met Muffin's breeder and his half-brother.

We have competed and won regularly at dressage at Novice and Elementary level, including coming 4th in Elementary section at UK Riders National Finals. The highlight of our dressage year has been finally doing a Medium test and coming 2nd with 65%.

I entered Muffin in the Native Pony Magazine Performance awards which ran from April to October. We came 1st in the Endurance section in April, 2nd overall in the Endurance section at the end of October and 4th overall in the dressage section. We are also the Southern Area Champion, Reserve Performance Champion and 1st in the Eastern Area for 2015."

In hand and overall reserve champion was Cellini owned by Kate Scorey. Cellini had a fantastic three year old year. He only left one show without a championship and he had numerous cuddly attempts with the first being at Devon County. He won the In Hands Concours D'Elegance at Equifest.

The Southern Awards are open to ponies owned or handled/ridden by an EPS member in the following areas: Exmoor, Devon and Cornwall, Somerset/Dorset/Wilts, Glos/Berks/Hants, South East, Eastern, Herts/Bucks/Oxon. The entry fee is just £5 per pony and entry forms can be downloaded from the EPS Website or obtained by SAE from J Wharton, 52 Finchcroft Lane, Prestbury, Cheltenham, Glos, GL52 5BG or by email j.wharton@live.co.uk The competition runs annually from 1st December to 30th November with points given for all ridden/in hand activities.
