RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Each exhibit entered with the correct fee will be given a serial number and will carry the number in all classes in which it is entered.
2. The correct age, name and pedigree (if known) must be sent in. If the Committee have reason to doubt the correctness of any statement made in the Entry Form or the qualification of any owner to enter his or her horse in any Class the Committee may take such steps as they think fit to ascertain the facts, regardless of whether any protest has been made and the Committee may at their discretion, exclude any horse from the ring or disqualify it, if it has been awarded any prize or premium
3. No exhibit, except Brood Mares, unbroken young stock, Mountain and Moorland and Exmoor ponies, may be shown unshod.
4. Brood Mares must have a foal at foot.
5. Measurements – where a height limit is given, height certificates from any approved Society will be accepted – otherwise all entries may be liable for measurement.
6. If the judge considers that any exhibit entered in a class does not comply with the conditions laid down for the class, they may request the exhibitor to withdraw from the class, but the exhibitor may show the same exhibit in another class without payment of any additional fee.
7. No substitutions will be permitted in any class after the closing date for entries.
8. Any exhibitor lodging a protest must deposit £10.00 with the Secretary. All protests must be made in writing and must be lodged within an hour of the class being judged. If the protest is not sustained the deposit will be forfeited. Decision of the Committee is final.
9. The Committee accept no responsibility for any accident that may happen to any animal, person or vehicle, and reserve the right to remove any animal in an unhealthy state.
10. Any class having less than 5 entries may be cancelled or amalgamated.
11. Classes are divided into two categories – Open and District. All classes are Open unless otherwise stated. For District Classes a Horse or Pony must have been, since 1st April 2016 the property of the entrant residing within a radius of 20 miles from the Showground.
12. Admittance to the Ground £15 per car to include catalogue to 2.00pm thereafter £5
13. Members' subscriptions of £8 per person or £12 per family to be paid by 15th July. Fully paid up Members will receive a car pass for designated parking area, Members' badges and use of light refreshment facilities in Members' enclosure.
14. Championship Classes – open to the 1st and 2nd prize winners from qualifying classes.
15. The Fortescue Cup is open to the Champion and Reserve Champion of the In-hand classes (26-33) and the Champion and Reserve Champion of the Ridden Hunters (34-36).
16. Exhibitors are not permitted to enter any animals in any Class which is to be judged by a person who has a financial interest in the animals or which have stood in his/her stable. Stud fees are not considered to be financial gain. The onus of complying with this regulation rests entirely on the Exhibitor.
17. All lorries must be parked in the competitors lorry park. There will be no exceptions.
18. Anyone on a horse at an affiliated show must wear a hard hat.
19. A skull cap or safety harness according to BSI Standard 4472 or 6473 must be worn by ALL Competitors on the jumping phase of working hunter or the show jumping classes (54-57). Skull caps must have a navy blue or black lining.
20. The organisers of this show have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For the measures to be effective, everyone must obey the instructions of the Organisers and all Officials and Stewards, please.

EXMOOR PONY SOCIETY CONDITIONS FOR EXMOOR PONIES

Ponies exhibited in Classes 1-12 to be led not ridden.

Classes 1-20 are open to registered ponies only (except foals).

Owners and riders must be fully paid up members of the Exmoor Pony Society.

All ponies to be registered in **Section One** of the Stud Book.

The Stud Book of the Exmoor Pony Society closed on 1st May 1962 to all ponies except those whose Sire and Dam are already registered.

Ponies must be exhibited in "natural condition" and not got up for Show.

Stallions and colts, 2 years old and over must be suitably bitted.

The exhibitor of any pony misbehaving will be asked to remove it from the ring immediately.

The Registered Herd and Pony number must be given of all ponies, except foals, entered in Classes 1-20 in addition to their names.

No spurs to be worn in ridden classes.

No assistance from outside the ring without the Judges permission.

Championship Cups only will be presented at prize giving.

Class Cups to be presented as each class concludes and then collected and signed for from the EPS Secretary.

To be eligible for an 'Exmoor Bred' Rosette or Trophy the pony must have been born into one of the following herds: Anchor, 4, 12, 23, 44, 99, 100, H8, H9, H17, H23, H42, H52, H67, 265, 320, 350, 387, 421, 423, 470

PLEASE NOTE: THAT CLASSES 10, 11, 12, 12A, 14 (PAIRS), 15 AND 16 MAY BE ENTERED ON THE DAY AT £7 PER ENTRY BEFORE 9.30am PROVIDED THE PONY IS ALREADY ENTERED IN A PRE-ENTERED CLASS.

**CLASS 10 STALLION PROGENY and
CLASS 10A MARE PROGENY**

The Classes are open to any three registered Exmoor's from one registered stallion who may be living, dead or gelded. The group to be exhibited together and may be any age or sex including geldings. A prize of £50.00 is offered to the best group. £10.00 to each individual pony and £20.00 to the stallion or mare who does not have to be present but, if on the Showground, must parade with his/her group.

The Angela Ashdown Memorial Trophy awarded by the Exmoor Pony Society to the owner of the sire of the winning stallion group. The Cowbridge Trophy kindly presented by Mr and Mrs H Crawford to the owner of the dam of the winning mare group. When completing entries for this Class, please give details for the stallion or mare only.

CLASS 11 BREEDERS GROUP

Open to three ponies from any one breeder who need not be the Exhibitor.

Challenge Cup kindly presented by the Exmoor Society, London Area Branch

Prize money of £30 to the winning group. Entry fee of £7 per entry.

CLASS 12 – JUNIOR HANDLERS, aged 8 years and under.

Ponies to be 4 years old and over Handling pure-bred mares and geldings

Confined to Junior members of the Exmoor Pony Society 8 years and under on show day.

CLASS 12A – JUNIOR HANDLERS aged 9 to 14 years.

Ponies to be 4 years old and over. Handling pure bred mares and geldings

Confined to Junior members of the Exmoor Pony Society 14 years and under on show day.

Hard hats must be worn by Junior Handlers. This Class will be judged on the Handler's ability to exhibit the Pony and not the pony itself. Entry fee is £7 per entry.

The Chichester Trophy presented by Mrs B A Chichester to the best Pony suitable to be handled by a child.

Trophies for the best handlers. Rosettes to all competitors.

For Pure-bred Exmoor Pony Stallion, Mare or Gelding aged 4 years or over to be ridden

For Pure-bred Exmoor Pony Mare or Gelding aged 4 years or over to be ridden by a Junior Member of the Exmoor Pony Society who must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have attained their 9th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Classes 17 and 18 must be pre-entered at £7 per entry.

CLASS 17 - JUNIOR RIDDEN

This class must be pre-entered

For Pure-bred Exmoor Pony Mare or Gelding aged 4 years or over to be ridden by a Junior Member of the Exmoor Pony Society who has not attained their 14th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

CLASS 18 - NOVICE RIDDEN

This class must be pre-entered

For Pure-bred Exmoor Pony Stallion, Mare or Gelding aged 4 years or over to be ridden by a Full, Family or Junior Member of the Exmoor Pony Society. Pony not to have won a first prize of £10.00 by the 1st January in the year of the Show and to be shown in a snaffle bridle.

CLASS 20 NPS/BAILEYS HORSE FEEDS OPEN RIDDEN – HOYS QUALIFIER

For Pure-bred Exmoor Pony Stallion, Mare or Gelding, aged 4 years old and over.

Riders and Owners must be Full, Family or Junior Members of the Exmoor Pony Society or NPS Ponies (UK), The Showing Register or BSPS

The “Harmony” Challenge Cup to the winner of this class kindly presented by Mrs G Bawden

Special rosette to the highest placed Junior Member.

To be run under NPS Breed Show Rules 2017.

Entry Fee £19.00 (which includes £12.00 Horse of the Year Show contribution)

This competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings, four years old and over, to be registered in, and complying with the showing requirements of, the main body of their respective stud books. Riders and Owners must be members of their respective Breed Society, NPS, Ponies (UK), The Showing Register or BSPS. Ponies must not exceed the height limits as stipulated by the relevant Breed Societies. Riders of stallions must have obtained their 12th birthday (small breeds) or 14th birthday (large breeds) before 1st January in the current year.

This class will be run in accordance with the general rules as set out in the Horse of the Year Show rulebook, a copy of which can be downloaded from www.hoys.co.uk.

Marks will be awarded in the following way:

Show, freedom of action - 50 maximum

Breed type and conformation - 50 maximum

In the case of equality, the pony with the highest show, freedom of action mark will be deemed the winner. If there is still equality at this point, then the judges' decision will be final.

This class is a qualifying class for Horse of the Year Show, NEC, Birmingham, 4 - 8 October 2017. Qualification will not pass below 3rd Place. Qualification will be verified by the Horse of the Year Show office.

This class is also a qualifier for the NPS/Ringside Stud Open Ridden M&M National Championship 2018

SILVER MEDAL ROSETTE (RIDDEN) to be judged under NPS Rules

NPS/The Minns Family Mountain and Moorland Ridden Silver Medal Rosette Championship. Silver Medal is offered by the NPS for the Best Section ONE registered Exmoor pony in Classes 15 to 20 (Ridden). If the Champion Pony has already qualified the Reserve will receive the qualification. Qualification will go no lower than 3rd place. Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the NPS/The Minns Family Mountain and Moorland Ridden Silver Medal Rosette Championship at the NPS Summer Show 2018

RIDDEN MOOR BRED CHAMPIONSHIP

The highest placed Exmoor bred Pony in Classes 15 to 20 to compete for the Moorland Breeders Trophy.

RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP

1st and 2nd placed ponies from Classes 15 to 20 to compete for the Warren Trophy kindly presented by the Exmoor National Park Authority. EPS Pony of the Year qualifier.

The Miles Bowl awarded to the stallion with the most points from the Royal Bath and West (in hand), Devon County (in hand) and Breed Show (in-hand).

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members and at breed shows ponies can qualify for finals even if their owners are not members. Owners of qualifying ponies must become adult Qualifying or Life members to enter the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern in August 2018.
