IN HAND CLASSES

- Class 1 Senior Condition & Turnout** - For ponies 4 years & over need not be registered, conformation will not be considered, to be judged purely on presentation of pony & handler. Ponies to be shown in hand. **(Sponsored by Pegasus Farriery).**
- Class 2 Mares 4 years & over barren or with foal at foot**- Ponies must be registered. THE PINKERY TROPHY for best mare. **(Sponsored by Sheena Clifford).**
- Class 3 Foals**
- Class 4 Stallion & Gelding 4 years & over** – Ponies must be registered & stallions must be licensed and wear a stallion bridle disc. This class will be split by age if sufficient entries. DHOWAL CUP for Best Stallion. MARLYN BALIVANICH trophy for Best Gelding. **(Sponsored by Alex Ingram).**
- Class 5 Veteran Pony In Hand** – Ponies to be registered and aged 16yrs & over **(sponsored by Grace & Robert Bisset).**

Senior Championship – 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 2, 4 & 5 are eligible to compete. MOUNT LOTHIAN CUP. Champion & Reserve qualify for EPS Exmoor pony of the Year final 2019 **(Sponsored by Michael Western)**

- Class 6 Young stock Condition & Turnout** - For ponies 3 years & under need not be registered, conformation will not be considered, to be judged purely on presentation of pony & handler. **(Sponsored by Michael Dewhurst).**
- Class 7 Yearling** – Colt, filly or gelding registered ponies only.
- Class 8 2 year old** – Colt, filly or gelding registered ponies only, colts to be bitted and wearing a bridle disc
- Class 9 3 year old** – Colt, filly or gelding, registered ponies only, colts to be bitted and wearing a bridle disc

Young stock Championship – 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 3, 7-9 are eligible to enter. Champion to receive the ALEMOOR QUAICH. Young stock Champion & Reserve qualify for EPS Exmoor pony of the Year final 2019. **(Sponsored by Jo Heslop).**

RIDDEN CLASSES

- Class 10 Lead Rein Pony** - Ponies must be registered, ridden in a snaffle bridle with lead rein attached to the nose band. Rider to be 8 years and under on the day of the show. No stallions in this class. JACK SPARROW SHIELD for the Winner. **(Sponsored by Kim Miller)**.
- Class 11 Childs Ridden Pony** - Registered ponies only & rider to be 16 years or under on the day of the show. Ponies will be required to canter together. No Stallions in this class. THE POSH CUP for the winner. **(Sponsored by Jacqueline Dow)**.
- Class 12 Novice Ridden Pony** - Registered ponies only, not to have won a first prize in an open class before 1st January 2017; to be show in snaffle bridle. **(Sponsored by Sheena Clifford)**.
- Class 13 Open Ridden Pony** - Ponies must be registered. **(Sponsored by Clunie & Melville)**
- Class 14 Family Ridden Pony-** Pony to be ridden by an adult and a child (16yrs or under) (child can be lead rein). Pony need not be registered. Winner not eligible for ridden championship but is eligible for the performance championship. SKELBO CUP for winner **(Sponsored by Grace & Robert Bisset)**.
- Class 15a Working Hunter Pony (Snr)** – Jumps not to exceed 2ft. Section X ponies / unregistered ponies may enter but will not be eligible for trophy or championship. WHETTER ROSE BOWL for Winner. BEINN THEIN TROPHY for Junior Winner. **(Sponsored by Lizzie Raspin)**.
- Class 15b Working Hunter Pony (Jnr)** – Jumps not to exceed 2ft. Rider to be 16 years or under on the day of the show. Section X ponies / unregistered ponies may enter but will not be eligible for trophy or championship. BEINN THEIN TROPHY for Winner. **(Sponsored by James Gillon)**.

Ridden Championship – 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 10-13 & 15 are eligible. WHITEBRIDGE SHIELD. Ridden Champion & Reserve qualify for EPS Ridden Exmoor pony of the Year final 2019. **(Sponsored by Jen McLaren)**

OTHER CLASSES

- Class 16 Bred in Scotland** – Any age or sex registered pony. GLEN ALBYN QUAICH for the winner. **(Sponsored by Karen Kidd)**.
- Class 17 Bred outside of Scotland-** Any age or sex registered pony. **(Sponsored by Gillian Birnie)**
- Class 18 Young Handler-** Ponies need not be registered. The handler's skill & ring craft to be judged not the pony's conformation. Handlers to be 16yrs or under on the day of the show. BEINN STROME JUNIOR HANDLER AWARD TROPHY to winner **(Sponsored by Clunie & Melville)**.
- Class 19 Related pairs** - Ponies need to be registered and class can be entered on the day. **(Sponsored by Clunie & Melville)**.

Handy pony classes- will be run from 10.30am onwards.

Class 20 Handy Pony Ridden - Ponies need not be registered. Ponies can be entered more than once but must have a different rider each time. STAIGER CUP for best ridden handy pony. **(Sponsored by Sheena Clifford)**.

Class 21 Handy pony in hand – Ponies 4 years and over. Ponies can be entered more than once but must have a different handler each time. IN HAND HANDY PONY MEMORIAL TROPHY CARN NAN ABRACH 2009-2017 to the winner **(Sponsored by Sheena Clifford)**.

Class 22 Handy Pony In Hand - Ponies under 4 years old need not be registered. Ponies can be entered more than once but must have a different handler each time. **(Sponsored by Sheena Clifford)**.

Supreme Championship – Young stock champion & reserve, senior champion & reserve & ridden champion & reserve to compete for the SCORRAIG TROPHY. There will also be a portrait done by Jane Wills for the Supreme Winner. **(Sponsored by Fiona Dickson)**.

Performance Championship – SCOTTISH SHOW TANKARD

Points will be awarded for classes 10-15 & 20 based on places as follows: - 1st 6 pts, 2nd 5 pts, 3rd 4 pts, 4th 3pts, 5th 2pts and 1 point for taking part but unplaced. **(Sponsored by Jo Heslop)**

If time permits there will be Clear Round Jumping over the Working Hunter Jumps at the end of the day for those that are interested. The cost will be £5 per entry and there will be rosettes for all clear rounds.

Stabling

Stabling will be available at the venue and nearby at the following costs.

Linfield Farm Stabling – This costs £30 per stable for first night and £20 for subsequent nights. This includes bedding, haylage and muck out). (There will be approximately 6 stables here).

Neighbouring stabling – This costs £25 per night to include bedding (stables must be emptied before leaving) (approx. 8-10 stables here).

Please book stables early.

A deposit of £10 per stable must be paid by 27th August.

Lorries can be parked overnight and the yard owner is happy for people to stay in them.

Dogs are welcome but there is a very strict rule that they MUST be kept on leads AT ALL TIMES as there is livestock on the farm.

Directions to Venue

From Perth, take the A93 heading towards Crieff. Drive through Methven. You will pass Blue Skies Bachilton Barn Wedding Venue (Strathearn Eventing) on the LHS. Take the next road on the right, then take the first drive on right and follow up drive to car park.
