- Class 1.           **Exmoor Pony Stallion, 4 years old and over.**  
The Poul Poulsen Trophy will be awarded to the winner of this class
- Class 2.           **Exmoor Pony Gelding. 4- 8 years old**  
The Faulkner Vase will be awarded to the winner of this class
- Class 3.           **Exmoor Pony Gelding. 9 years old and over**  
The Inholmes Applesweet Trophy will be awarded to the winner of this class
- Class 4.           **Exmoor Pony Mare, 4 - 8 years old,**  
The Ruscarrol Trophy will be awarded to the winner of this class
- Class 5.           **Exmoor Pony Mare 9 years old and over**  
The Hock Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the winner of this class.
- Class 6.           **Exmoor Pony Foal.**  
Out of mare entered in class 4 or 5 and eligible to be registered in the main section of the EPS stud book.
- Class 7.           **Veteran.**  
Open to ponies 15 years old & over.  
The Thimble Wizard Trophy will be awarded to the winner of this class

## Senior In Hand Championship.

1st and 2nd prize winners from **classes 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 & 7** to compete for the **Hudson Trophy**. Rosettes to Champion and Reserve. The Senior In Hand Champion and Reserve go forward to the Overall In Hand Championship.

**The Senior In Hand Champion and Reserve qualify for Pony Of The Year competition**

## Youngstock Classes:

Class 8. **Exmoor Pony Yearling, any sex.**  
**The Pinkery Erica Trophy** will be awarded to the winner of this class  
Northern Area premium £10 to winner of this class

Class 9. **Exmoor Pony 2 Year Old, any sex**  
Northern Area premium £10 to winner of this class

Class 10. **Exmoor Pony 3 Year Old, any sex.**  
Northern Area premium £10 to winner of this class

## Youngstock Championship.

1st and 2nd prize winners from **classes 6, 8, 9 & 10** to compete. **Catmoggett Cup** to Champion, **Cinnamon Trophy** to Reserve.

**The Youngstock Champion and Reserve qualify for Pony Of The Year competition**

## Gelding Championship

**Highest placed** gelding from classes 2, 3, 7, 8, 9 & 10 are eligible. The **Sweetworthy Trophy** will be awarded to Champion, **Market Refrigeration Trophy** to reserve

## Female Championship

**Highest placed** mare or filly from classes 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 & 10 are eligible. **The Widdenhill Bucket Trophy** will be awarded to the Champion. **The Viburnum Memorial Trophy** will be awarded to the Reserve Champion

## Overall In Hand Championship

**Youngstock Champion and Reserve, Gelding Champion and Reserve, Female Champion and Reserve and Senior In Hand Champion and Reserve** are eligible. **The Nita Ferrar Memorial Trophy** will be awarded to the Champion. **The Sunset Brandy's Boy Trophy** will be awarded to the Reserve Champion. **The Overall In Hand Champion & Reserve** go forward to the **Supreme Championship**

***The Champion and Reserve will qualify for the NPS Area 4 Northern Breeders Final sponsored by "MP GLOSS Products UK" to be held at the NPS Area 4 North Of England Show. Entry to the final is free. Schedule and details can be found on the website [npsarea4.com](http://npsarea4.com)***

## **Open Classes:**

- Class 11. Child Handler**  
Mares & geldings only. Child to be under 16 years on the day of the Show. To be judged on presentation only, conformation will not be taken into account.  
**The Seaside Ivanhoe Trophy** will be awarded to the winner of this class. Rosettes to all competitors.
- Class 12 Senior Handler.**  
Handler 16 years and over on the day of the show. To be judged on presentation only, conformation will not be taken into account
- Class 13 Exmoor Pony, any age or sex, bred in the Northern Area.**  
**The Kebroyd Stud Tankard** will be awarded to the winner of this class.
- Class 14. Exmoor Pony, any age or sex, bred anywhere other than the Northern Area.**  
**The Greenfield Cup** will be awarded to the winner of this class.  
**The Fraggle Cup** will be awarded to the Best Moorbred Pony
- Class 15. Exmoor Ponies, related pairs. Entry fee £10 per pair**  
Two ponies, full or half siblings, dam/sire or son/daughter.  
Open only to ponies already entered in another class. Entries on the day or in advance.  
**The Gruesome Twosome** trophies will be awarded to the winners of this class
- Class 16. Handy Pony**  
Ridden or in-hand. Present ponies between  
10:30– 14:00
- Class 17. Clear Round Jumping. Entry fee £2.00 per round**  
Entries on the day or in advance. **Please note, this class will only run if we have 10 or more entries.**
- Class 18. Turnout**  
Ridden or In Hand. To be judged purely on turnout of pony and rider/handler.  
Ponies to be presented individually to the judge.

## Ridden Classes.

### **Class 20. Lead Rein**

Mares & Geldings only. Riders must not have attained their 9<sup>th</sup> birthday on the day of the show. To be shown in a snaffle bit. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband. Rosettes to all competitors in this class.

**The Becky & Bob** trophy will be awarded to the winner of this class

### **Class 21 Junior Ridden**

Open to mares & geldings four years old & over. Rider must not have attained their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday on the day of the show. Rosette to all competitors in this class.

**The Withypool Trophy** will be awarded to the winner of this class.

### **Class 22. NPS Novice Ridden**

Ponies not to have won first prize in an open class before 1<sup>st</sup> January 2018. To be shown in a snaffle bridle.

**The First Time Trophy** will be awarded to the winner of this class

The NPS/PICTON M&M Novice Ridden National Championship. a) Stallions, mares and geldings four years old and over, registered in the main body of their respective Breed Society stud book.

A pony is not eligible to compete if, before 1st January in the current year, it has done any of the following: i. Won an open affiliated mixed M&M Ridden class ii. Qualified for Horse of the Year Show, Olympia or RIHS Open M&M Ridden classes iii. Qualified for the M&M Novice or Intermediate Ridden final at the NPS Summer Championship show (N.B. Ponies can compete as novices in this competition for two consecutive years provided they do not submit an entry to the final in the first year). iv. If a pony qualifies for Horse of the Year Show, Olympia or RIHS in its second year it is immediately de-noviced and cannot compete in the Picton Final.

Rider any age, except stallions (see rules in section A 3.2). Breed Show Rules- Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members and at breed shows ponies can qualify for finals even if their owners are not members. Owners of qualified ponies must become adult Qualifying or Life members to enter the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 6th – 8th August 2019.

The highest placed pony, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

### **Class 23. Open Ridden Exmoor Pony.**

Open to Stallions mares, geldings, four years old and over

**Teagle Nere Miss Trophy** will be awarded to the winner of this class.

## Ridden Championship

1st and 2nd prize winners from **classes 20 -23** to compete for the **Mrs V Cooper Trophy**. Rosettes to Champion and Reserve. Champion & Reserve go forward to the Supreme Championship.

**The Ridden Champion and Reserve qualify for the Pony Of The Year competition**

***Special Rosette to best Veteran pony***

## **SUPREME CHAMPIONSHIP**

Overall In Hand Champion and Reserve, Ridden Champion & Reserve compete for **the Darnbrook Rosebowl**.

The **Loved & Lost Trophy** to be awarded to the Reserve

Supreme Champion and Reserve to receive sashes.

## **Owner Bred Trophy**

**The Twolads Trophy** and Rosette are offered to the best pony owned and bred by the exhibitor. This will be awarded on a points basis, points allocated for 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> place in all classes as below

1<sup>st</sup> = 6 points

2<sup>nd</sup> = 5 points

3<sup>rd</sup> = 4 points

4<sup>th</sup> = 3 points

5<sup>th</sup> = 2 points

6<sup>th</sup> = 1 point

## **Child Friendly Trophy**

**The Whittington Family Trophy** will be awarded to the pony considered by both judges to be the most child friendly

### Rules

- All Ponies must be registered in the main section of the EPS stud book. Registration numbers & breeding must be quoted on the entry form or the entry will not be accepted.
- All Ponies entered in Ridden Classes must be 4 years old or over. Spurs are not allowed in any ridden class.
- Brood Mares must be 4 years old or over. Foals must be at least 3 weeks old on the day of the Show and must accompany their dam into the ring and be led alongside the mare as much as possible.
- Stallions or colts 3 years old or over must have an Exmoor Pony Society licence. Stallions and colts 2 years old or over must be bitted. Stallions not under proper control will be asked to leave the Showground. Riders of stallions must have attained their 12th birthday before January 1st of the current year Handlers of stallions or colts must have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January of the current year. No stallions in classes 11, 20 & 21.
- No liability for any injury or loss to any person, animal or goods will be accepted by the Exmoor Pony Society, Show organisers or owners of the venue. It is solely the responsibility of each individual attending this event to ensure that they have adequate insurance cover.
- Correctly secured current British standard skull caps/riding hats must be worn at all times while mounted. Handlers aged 16 years and under of ponies in In Hand classes must wear correctly secured current British standard skull caps/riding hats.
- The Judges decision is final. We do not encourage complaints. Any complaint must be made to the secretary NOT to judges or stewards. If you really must complain, your complaint will only be heard by the Secretary on receipt of a £50 fee which is not refundable and will be given to charity. There is no right of appeal against any decision made by the Secretary as a result of hearing any such complaint.
- The organisers reserve the right to alter, amalgamate, divide or cancel any classes as required.
- This Show qualifies for double points in the Northern Area & Midlands Area Exmoor Points Competition
- Classes may be entered on the day as long as the pony is pre entered in at least one class. Except for classes 15, 16 & 17 there will be an extra charge of £2.00 per class.
