Selected stories may be used for Supper and Storytelling events as part of the programme of celebrations and entries may be published as a collection at some future date.

Stories must be fictional, the entrant's own original work and no longer than 2000 words. They must include an Exmoor pony or Exmoor ponies as a major component of the story.

Prizes

Rosettes will be awarded for 1st – 6th place
The overall winner will receive a £100 book token

Entries close on the 1st August 2020

RULES/CONDITIONS OF ENTRY - Please read carefully

1. The competition is open to professionals and amateurs.
2. Maximum number of entries per person is two stories.
3. Each story should be no longer than 2,000 words
4. Entries, which must be accompanied by a completed entry form, should be emailed (preferred) to secretary@exmoorponysociety.org.uk or posted to: The Secretary, Exmoor Pony Society, Woodmans, Brithem Bottom, Cullompton, Devon, EX15 1NB.
5. It is the responsibility of the entrant to advise the Exmoor Pony Society should any contact details change between the point of entry and the end of October 2020.
6. A condition of entry is that entries can be used by the Exmoor Pony Society as part of Centenary events and may be reproduced freely by the Exmoor Pony Society.
7. The overall winner and 2nd to 6th placed entrants will be notified by email or post and a list of results will be posted on the EPS website.
