

## Rules

1. Judges decision is final
2. Ridden ponies to be 4 years and over.
3. Hard hats must be worn when mounted and by children 16 years and under leading a pony in hand.
4. No liability for any injury or loss to any person, animal or goods will be accepted by the organisers or owners of the venue.
5. Riders and handlers of stallions should be over 12 years of age
6. Passports must accompany all ponies.

The Committee hope you enjoy the Somerset Exmoor Pony Show and that you will take the opportunity to socialise and most of all, have a fun day with or without ponies.

There will be a raffle on the day and prize donations are welcome.

### **Please Note that for Classes 12 & 14 the following applies:**

NPS Qualifying Rounds, Breed Show Rules: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part bred are not eligible for Mountain & Moorland Classes.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members and at breed shows ponies can qualify for finals even if their owners are not members. Owners of qualified ponies must become adult Qualifying or Life members to enter the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from **6th—8th August 2019**.

The highest placed pony, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show.

Best pony bred in Somerset- *Rosette to best owner bred pony. Trophy to Best Pony bred in Somerset donated by Teagle Exmoor Stud*

#### Class 11

Best Pony bred outside Somerset- *Rosette to best owner bred pony, Shield to Best Pony bred outside Somerset donated by the Committee*

### **RIDDEN CLASSES (to follow on from class 11)**

Class 12- Lead Rein Pony- rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year, no stallions .The lead rein must be attached to the noseband. **NPS Qualifier**

*The NPS/Showing Classics M&M Leading Rein National Championship (MM-LR)*  
*Open to registered Exmoor mares and geldings four years old or over not exceeding 122 cm. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have attained their 9th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. To be shown in a snaffle bit.NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship – wear white arm bands.*

#### Class 13

Novice Ridden Pony, open to stallions, mares and geldings 4 years and over. Not to have won a cash prize of £10.00 or more. To be shown in a snaffle bit.  
*Godsgrace Trophy donated by Rev'd A Steele*

#### Class 14

Open Ridden Pony, open to stallions, mares and geldings. **NPS Qualifier**  
*The NPS/Ringside Stud M&M Open Ridden National Championship (MM-OR)*  
*Open to registered pure bred Exmoor stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over.NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship – wear white arm bands. Ridden stallions MUST display a stallion bridle marker available from the NPS office or from any other society.*

### Ridden Championship

Ponies placed 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> in classes 13-15 eligible for Ridden Championship.  
*Jiminy Cricket Trophy to Ridden Champion donated by the late Irene Nash and Marion Williams.*
